<p>The final annual stakeholder meeting was held on November 20th 20 2023. The event was attended by representatives of organisations, leaders and activists involved in the project activities as well as the project team.</p> <p>The meeting was an opportunity for the consortium partners to present a summary of the project and a wrap-up the process of creating the Difficult Heritage Remembrance Framework (DHRF). It was also a chance to reflect on the progress of building the network around the project. There was a discussion about the project results and the continuation of activities, processes and collaborations initiated during the project. We are glad that new stakeholders and collaborators have been joining us throughout the project, including the newly established Foundation <i>Miejsce Uwagi</i>, which was present during the meeting on Nov 20th, shortly after we started our cooperation. .</p>
